On the CALL Significant Activity



On 11/2/22, officers responded to the area of Yankee Road for a wrong way driver complaint. The vehicle was located and the suspect fled from officers. The suspect was later apprehended and charged with fleeing and eluding and reckless operation. OVI charges are pending.

On 11/9/22, officers responded to the area of Bourdeaux Way in reference to a domestic involving a weapon. Officers made contact with the complainant at the scene and based on the information provided, the suspect was arrested for domestic violence, aggravated menacing, and criminal damaging.

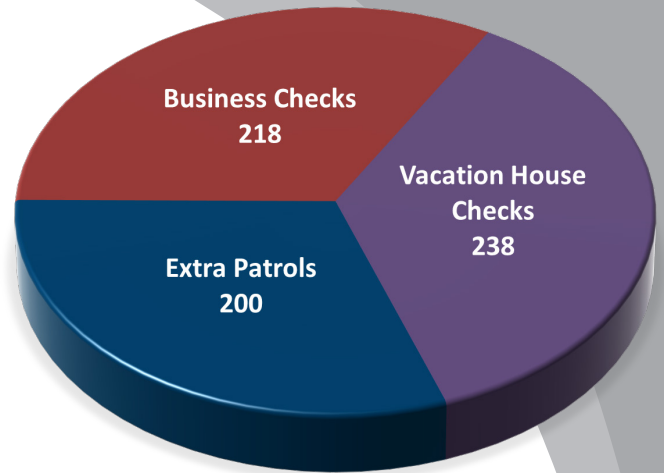

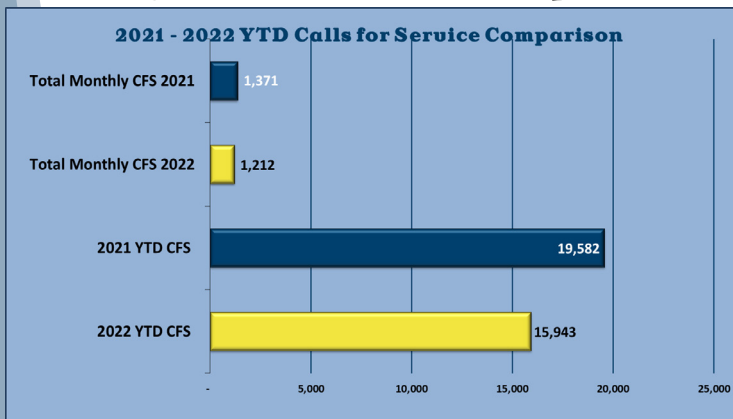

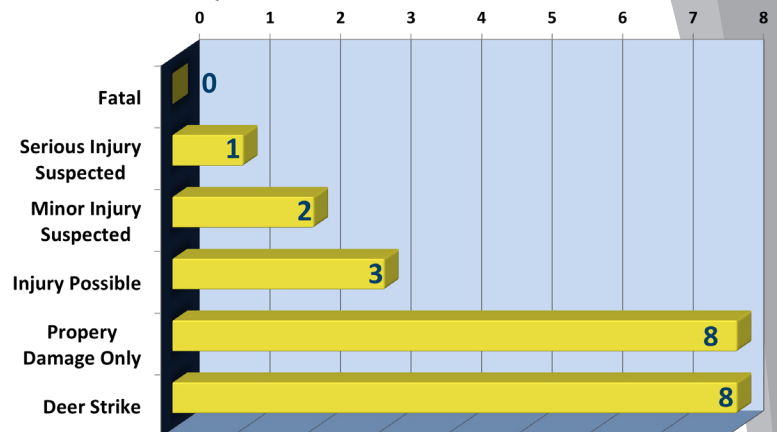
