On the CALL Significant Activity



On 12/10/22, officers responded to a report of an active burglary in the area of Red Lion Five Points Road. Officers made contact with all subjects on scene and discovered that a family member, involved in a domestic violence incident earlier in the day, had returned to the residence. Based on the information provided, both parties agreed to separate for the evening and no charges were filed.

On 12/12/22, officers responded to the area of Lower Springboro Road for a reported employee theft. Officers made contact with the complainant at the scene. A report was taken and the case has been turned over to the detective section for further investigation.

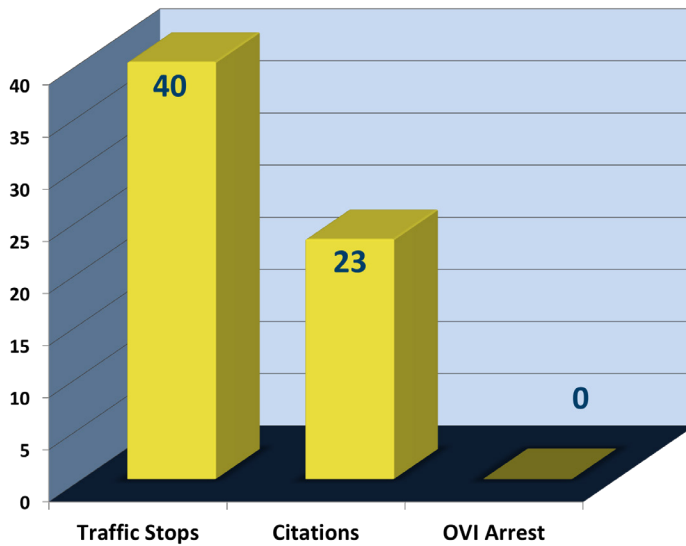
On 12/13/22, officers were dispatched to the area of North State Route 48 and West State Route 122 for juveniles fighting. The officers responded to the scene, found that the fight had ended and located a suspect. The suspect was charged with Disorderly Conduct.

On 12/13/22, officers responded to the area of West State Route 122 and North State Route 48 to look for a vehicle that had been involved in a pursuit elsewhere in the county. When located, the suspect fled from officers. The suspect was eventually apprehended and charged with Fleeing and Eluding, Obstructing Official Business, Possession of a Controlled Substance, and Reckless Operation.

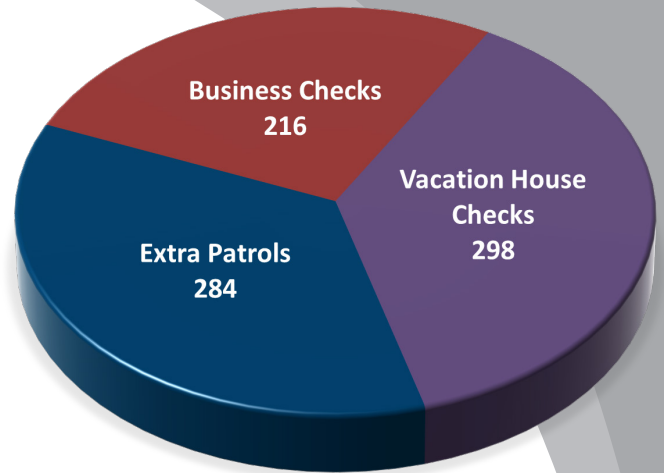

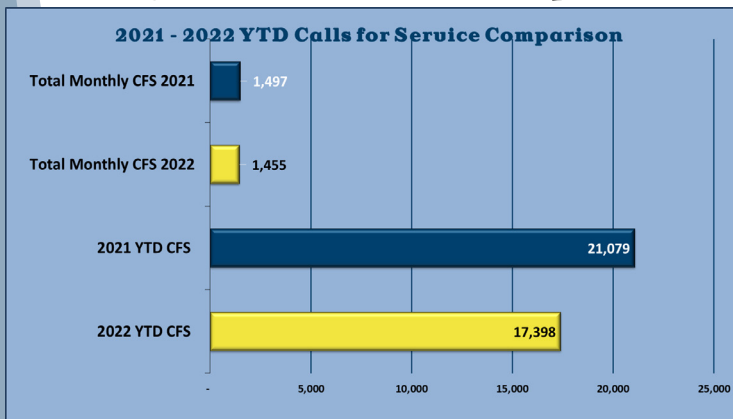

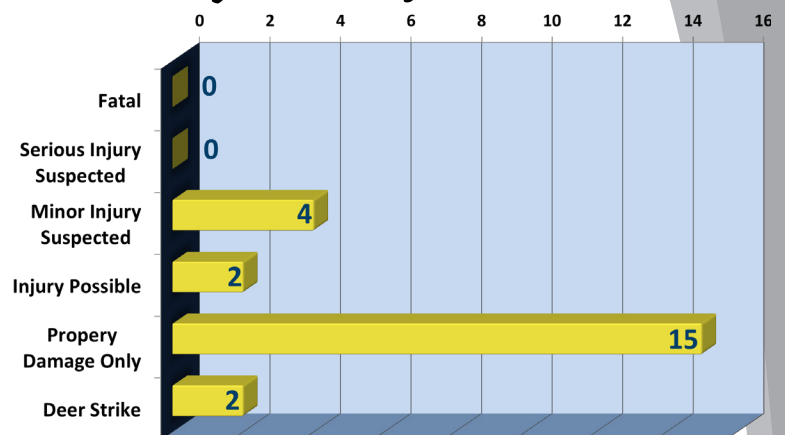
