Significant Activity



On 6/4/22 @ 10:12 hours, Officer Armstrong was dispatched to the 5400 block of Hathaway in reference to a stolen vehicle. The vehicle owner reported that his 2002 Jeep had been stolen sometime between 21:30 and 22:00 hours on June 3rd. Detective Sergeant Barton recovered the Jeep on June 24th in Englewood, OH, after someone had purchased a new temporary tag for the vehicle. The investigation is ongoing.

On 6/7/22 @ 19:34 hours, officers were dispatched in reference to the complainant following what appeared to be an intoxicated driver driving on Lower Springboro Road within the city of Springboro. Springboro officers were able to follow the vehicle and observed several traffic violations. Springboro officers attempted to stop the vehicle at Lower Springboro Road and Rio Vista Court, but the driver refused to stop. After a short pursuit the vehicle stopped on Lower Springboro Road near Township Line Road. Clearcreek officers arrived and the driver was arrested for OVI and Failure to Comply with the Signal of a Police Officer.

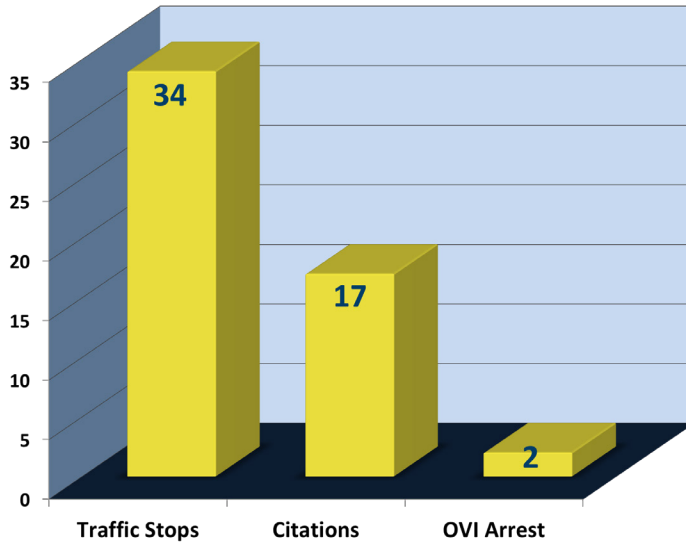
On 6/9/22, officers investigated the Theft of a purse from a vehicle that was parked at Patricia Allyn Park.

On 6/10/22 @ 12:05 hours, Officer Morgan, Officer Armstrong, and Sergeant Bates responded to a residence for a domestic call. Upon arrival, officers found that a juvenile had been yelling and throwing things at other family members. The juvenile struck a family member with a boot that was thrown. Officers were able to calm the youth and were able to clear, only to be dispatched back to the residence @ 13:05 hours. At that time, the youth had assaulted a family member and was arrested for Domestic Violence.

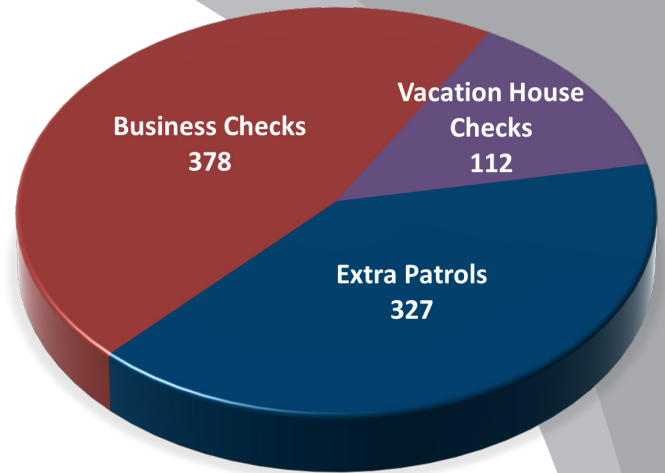
On 6/22/22 @ 10:00 hours, Officer Ney took an assault report at the Clearcreek Township Police Department. The complainants came to the police department to report that on June 17th, while working on a job site in the 5400 block of Bunnell Hill Road, they were assaulted by two other coworkers. The assault resulted in one of the victims receiving several facial bone fractures. The other was assaulted with an unknown metal weapon. Through further investigation Officer Ney was able to identify and charge the two suspects with Felonious Assault.

On 6/28/22, Officers investigated a Theft of credit cards that occurred in the 8300 block of Country Club Lane. The investigation is pending.

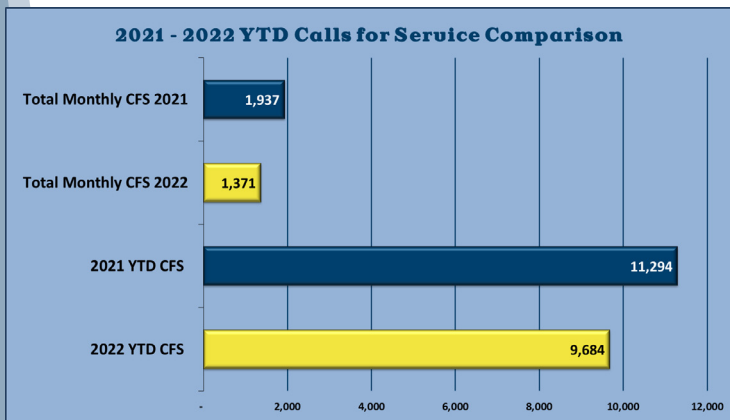
June Traffic Enforcement



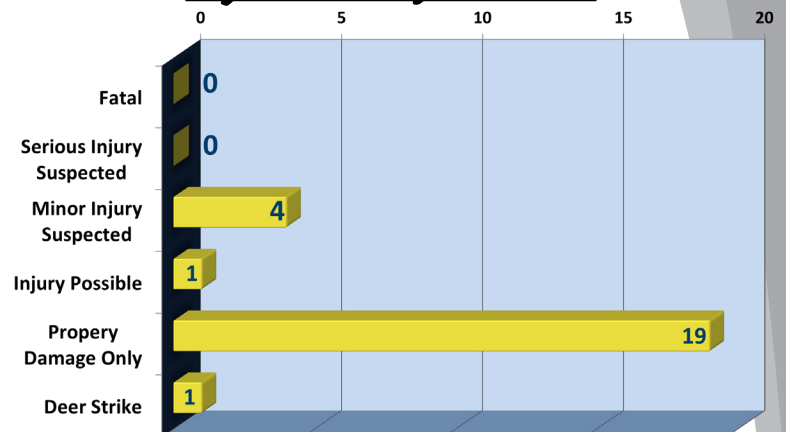
