Significant Activity

On 8/7/22, officers were dispatched to an active domestic complaint in the area of Lytle Five Points Road and Bunnell Hill Road. Officers arrived on scene and made contact with the victim. Upon investigating further, officers were able to identify the primary aggressor. The suspect was arrested and charged with domestic violence.

On 8/7/22, officers were dispatched to the area of North State Route 48 and State Route 73 for an intoxicated driver. While responding, dispatch advised the vehicle crashed in the 2700 block of East State Route 73. The driver was transported to the hospital. Upon further investigation, OVI charges were filed on the driver.

On 8/8/22, officers investigated a complaint of an assault that occurred in the area of Apple Blossom Lane. Contact was made with all involved subjects. Upon further investigation the incident has been referred to another agency to follow up with the family.

On 8/14/22, officers investigated thefts from vehicles in the 2900 block of Harlan Road and in the 2500

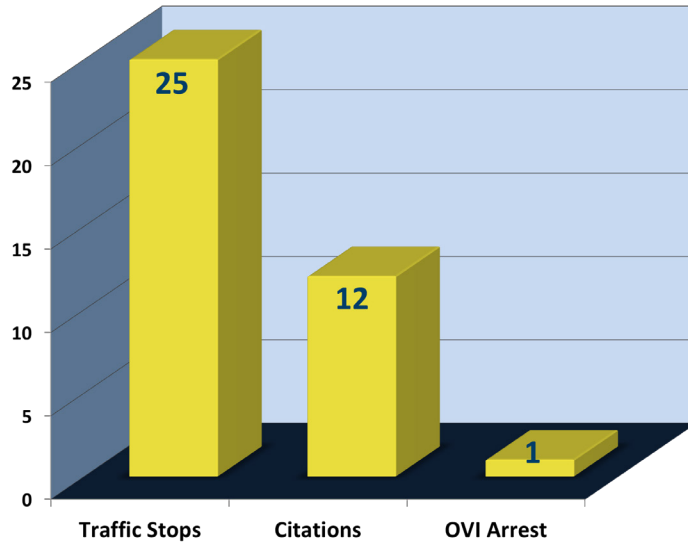
block of Jade Point Court. Contact was made with the complainants, the suspects are unknown, and the investigation is ongoing.

On 8/20/22, officers responded to an active domestic complaint in the 2800 block of West State Route 122. While on scene, officers made contact with the victim and were able to determine the identity of the primary aggressor. The suspect was arrested and charged with domestic violence.

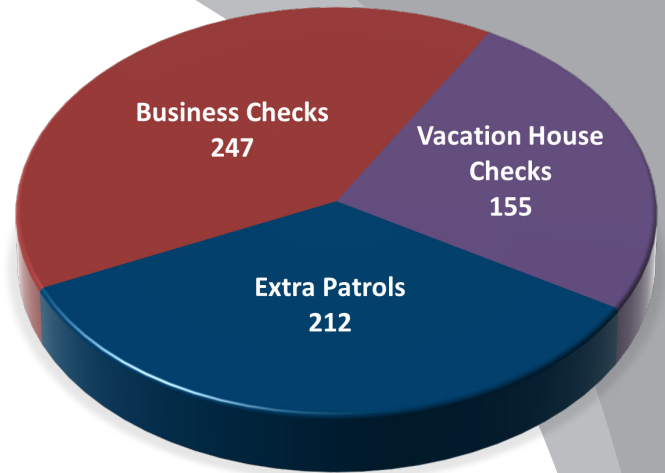
On 8/21/22, officers responded to a domestic complaint at the 3500 block of North State Route 741. Contact was made with the complainant and other family members on scene. Upon completion of the investigation, officers cleared the scene without charges.

On 8/27/22, officers responded to a theft complaint at the 7100 block of Red Lion Five Points Road. Contact was made with the complainant and the suspect remains unidentified at this time. The investigation is ongoing.

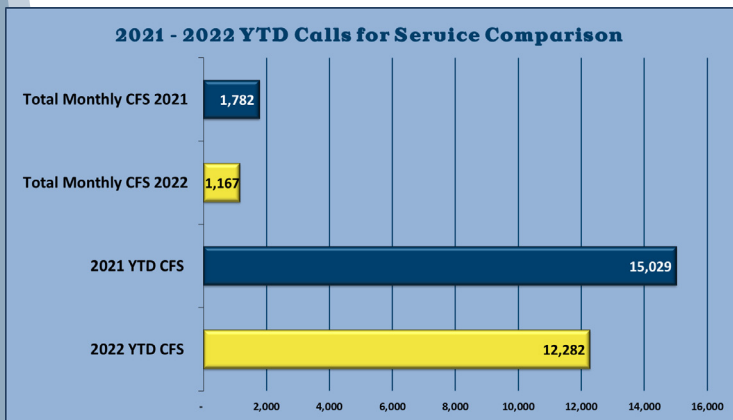

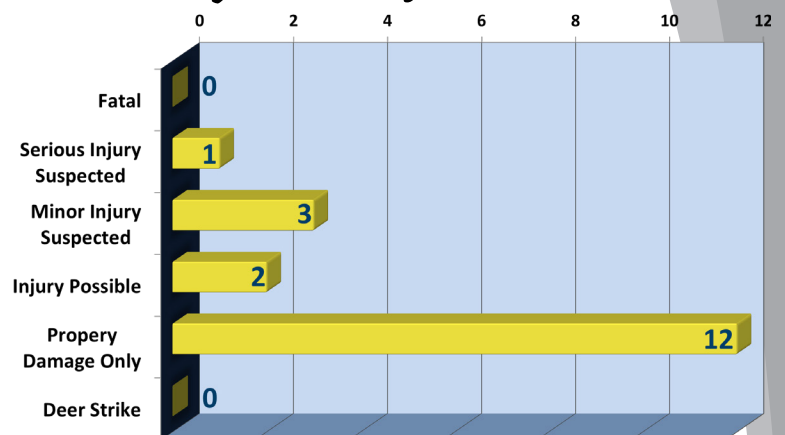
