



# Clearcreek Road Department

## Monthly Report

April 2022

Road Crews accomplished a lot in April despite a rainy start to the month. Crews completed an inventory of our infrastructure throughout the Township. Two crew members inspected catch basins and curbs throughout the township, while an additional two-person team inspected culvert pipes on all main roads and all ADA ramps for repair needs this year. Additionally, personnel completed the Mastermind Sign Inventory project, totaling 2,309 road signs throughout the township.

After completing equipment inspections, crews decided to remove the rusted bed off the service truck and added a flatbed to serve road maintenance needs better. In addition, the new truck bed includes side toolboxes and sideboards and a custom box for holding shovels, and sign stands fabricated by crew members. These customizations allow for maximum usage and efficiency.



The crew changed two driveway pipes on Grandview and ditched one ditch on Music Place the third week of April. Ending the month, crews completed ditching 1,000-feet on North Bunnell Hill, taking approximately two days. Finally, crews cleaned the ditch in front of Clearcreek Fire District Station 23 and along State Route 48.
