



# Clearcreek Road Department

## Monthly Report

June 2022

During June, the Road Department used the Mastic Patcher ahead of the paving crews, using 14,400 lbs. of mastic on roads. Using mastic to fill transverse roadway cracks before paving should prevent the damages from returning quickly and hopefully prevent a recurrence. The streets included in this project are Foxdale Drive, Magnolia Drive, Applewood Lane, Timber Walk Court, and Old Wood Court. Additionally, Road Crews repaired cracks on Apple Creek Lane, Apple Blossom Lane, Spice Court, Cider Court, Orchard Way, and Cobbler Court. Crews plan to seal these streets later in the year.



Crews started trimming trees on Harlan Road and will complete trimming along the entire street. Road Crews also removed a hazardous tree at Wiesenberger and Pekin Road.

In preparation for the upcoming striping project, crews began repairing the sides of North Red Lion Five Points Road. In June, they milled out and replaced 25 tons of asphalt.



To improve roadway safety, the Road Department added Rumble Stripes to the curve on North Bunnell Hill to help keep drivers in their lane.



In addition to road maintenance, crews mulched the landscaping at the Government Center.
