On the **CALL** *Significant Activity*



On 2/10/23, officers were dispatched to an active domestic in the area of Winding Creek Boulevard. Officers made contact with all subjects involved at the scene, and based on the information provided, officers arrested the primary aggressor. The suspect was charged with Domestic Violence and transported to Warren County Jail.

On 2/10/23, officers were dispatched to the 4300 block of North State Route 48 for a domestic complaint. Officers made contact with all subjects involved at the scene, and based on the information provided, officers could not determine the primary aggressor. No arrests were made, and both parties agreed to separate for the evening.

On 2/11/23, officers were dispatched to the area of Country Brook Court to investigate a complaint of a loud party/noise complaint. Officers arrived on scene and made contact with the resident, who was later found to be under the legal drinking age, and their parents were out of town. Officers issued a summons for Underage Consumption of Alcohol.

On 2/12/23, officers were dispatched to an intoxicated driver going north on State Route 48. Officers initiated a traffic stop, and upon further investigation, officers determined the driver was impaired. The driver was charged with Operating a Vehicle while Under the Influence and transported to the Warren County Jail.

On 2/13/23, officers were dispatched to the area of Applewood Lane for a domestic complaint/mental disorder. Officers made contact with all subjects involved at the scene and based on the information provided, no arrests were made for this incident. One of the subjects involved in the incident was transported to a medical facility for a mental evaluation.

On 2/13/23, officers were dispatched to an alleged sex offense complaint in the area of West Factory Road. Officers made contact with the complainant, and the investigation has been referred to the detective division for further investigation.

On 2/15/23, officers were dispatched to the area of Elm Brook Trail for a vehicle theft report. Officers made contact with the complainant, who advised the vehicle was left unlocked, and the spare key was inside the vehicle. The vehicle was later recovered by the Dayton Police Department.

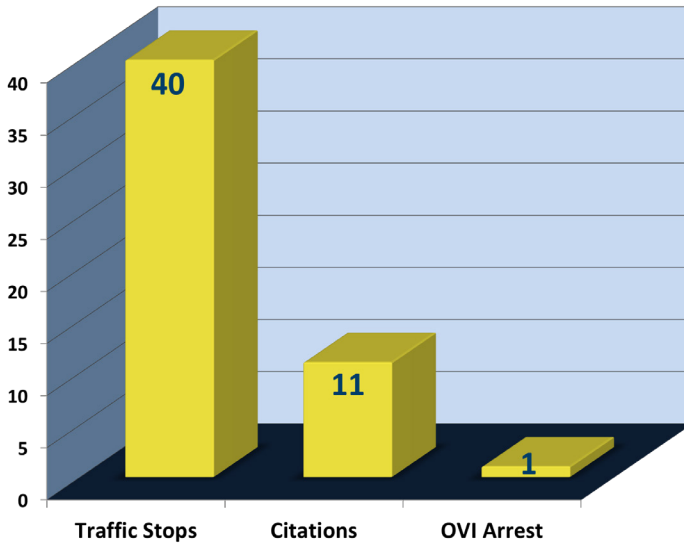
On 2/17/23, officers were dispatched to an alleged sex offense complaint in the area of Old State Route 122. Officers made contact with the complainant, and the investigation has been referred to the detective division for further investigation.

On 2/21/23, officers were dispatched to the area of Carnell Drive for a stolen ATV complaint. Officers made contact with the complainant, who advised the ATV was stolen from the rear of the residence. The ATV was entered into the LEADS database as stolen. There are no suspects at this time, and the investigation is pending.

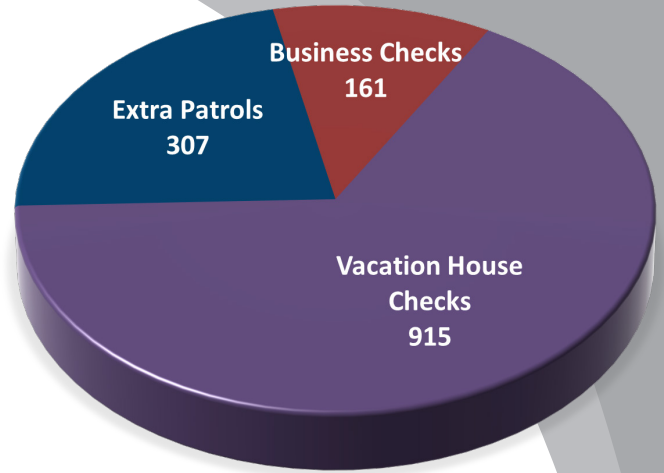
On 2/25/23, officers were dispatched to the area of West Factory Road for a stolen vehicle complaint. Officers made contact with the complainant, who advised the vehicle was taken from the residence overnight without their knowledge. The suspect was known and contacted by the officers. Shortly after, the vehicle was returned, and the complainant requested there be no charges for this incident.

On 2/28/23, while patrolling, officers initiated a traffic stop in the area of Township Line and Lytle Roads. During the stop, officers discovered the driver of the vehicle was under suspension, and shortly after, officers located another subject in the trunk of the vehicle. The passenger in the trunk was found to have active warrants out of the Warren County Sheriff's Office. The driver was cited for driving under suspension, and the passenger was transported to the Warren County Jail.

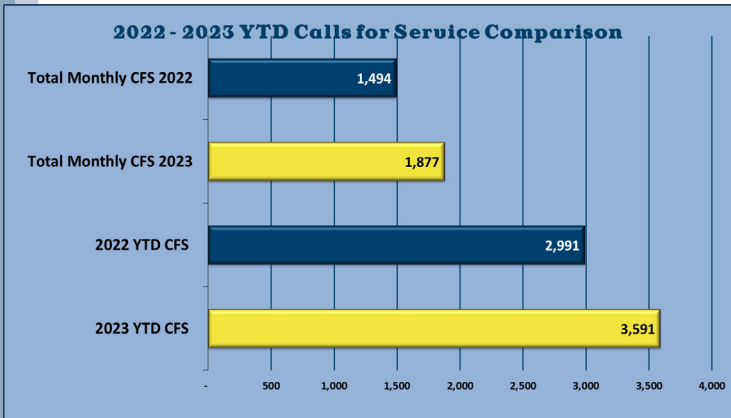

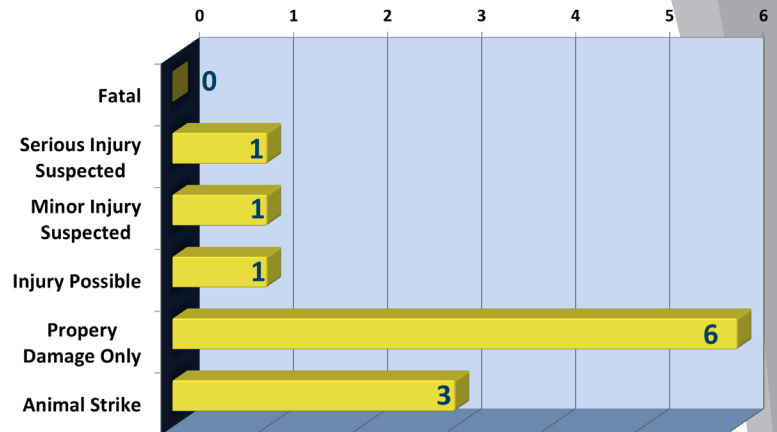

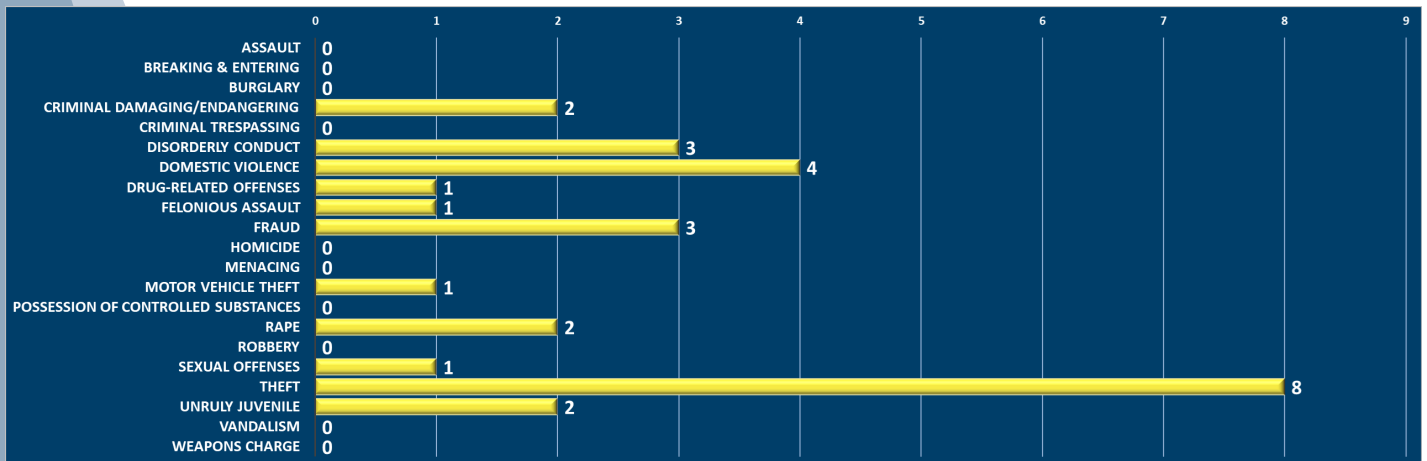
2022 - 2023 YTD Calls for Service Comparison
