All officers worked on 'Arrest, Search, and Seizure 2023' training through Ohio Peace Officer Training Academy.

All officers also recertified on CPR/AED through the Clearcreek Township Fire District.

Additionally, Officer Brian McWhorter completed 'Advanced Cannabis Impairment Training'.



On 3/3/23, Officer Bronnenberg responded to the Warren County Alternative School in reference to a student in possession of a knife. A juvenile suspect was charged with Illegal Conveyance into a School zone.

On 3/6/23, Corporal Blaha and Officer Hall initiated a traffic stop on East Lower Springboro Road just east of Bunnell Hill Road. The driver was arrested for OVI. He refused to submit to a breath test.

On 3/11/23, Officer Bronnenberg was dispatched to the area of State Route 741 near Ryan Road for a single-vehicle crash. The driver was arrested for OVI; he refused to submit to any tests. The suspect was also cited for Failure to Control and Expired Registration.

On 3/12/23, Officer Bronnenberg initiated a traffic stop in the 2000 block of East State Route 73. The driver was arrested for OVI and refused a breath test.

On 3/13/23, Officer Bronnenberg, Corporal Knobbe, and Sergeant Sweet responded to a Domestic in the 8700 block of North State Route 48. Upon arrival, they found that a suspect had fled. Officers began to check the area and located the suspect, who was arrested and charged with Domestic Violence, OVI, and being in possession of an Open Container of Alcoholic Beverage. He was then transported to the Warren County Jail.

On 3/13/23, Officer Knobbe and Sergeant Sweet responded to the 8700 block of Sycamore Trails Drive for a Domestic. Upon investigation, the primary aggressor was arrested for Domestic Violence and transported to Warren County Jail.

On 3/17/23, officers responded to a suspicious vehicle in the 8200 block of Crossley Road. The driver of the vehicle was checked and released. Later, a homeowner reported that surveillance cameras had captured the driver throwing a baggie of a suspected drug into the ditch as officers approached. Officers retrieved the baggie and contents. On 3/19/23, the subject returned to the home on Crossley. At that time, he was summonsed for Trespassing and released. Other charges are pending, depending upon lab results.

On 3/17/23, Officer Hall responded to UDF on State Route 122 for a vehicle crash in which the driver had driven over the curb and became stuck. Upon further investigation, the driver was arrested for OVI and transported to Warren County Jail.

On 3/18/23, Officer Hall and Sergeant Cordero were dispatched to an intoxicated driver complaint in the area of North State Route 48 and East State Route 73. The driver was arrested for OVI and refused to submit to any tests.



Officers met the victim prior to going to the home and found that she had been assaulted. Officers' attempts to make contact with the suspect were unsuccessful, so charges were filed and a warrant issued. The suspect was apprehended on 3/25/23 and taken to Warren County Jail.

On 3/28/23, Officer Morgan took a Motor Vehicle Theft report in the 2900 block of Beal Road. An investigation led to the vehicle being recovered in the City of Franklin. Officer Morgan assisted Franklin and turned the investigation over to them. Charges are pending.

On 3/30/23, Sergeant Bates charged two juveniles at the Alternative School for fighting.

On 3/31/23, Officer Bronnenberg charged a juvenile at the Alternative School for Disorderly Conduct and Menacing.




2022 - 2023 YTD Calls for Service Comparison




