Significant Activity



On 4/12/23, officers responded to a criminal damaging complaint in the area of Riley Wills Road. Officers made contact with the complainant who reported damage to a utility box and propane tank at the residence. There are no known suspects at this time and the investigation is ongoing.

On 4/12/23, officers were dispatched to the 8600 block of North State Route 48 for a domestic complaint. Officers made contact with all subjects involved at the scene and, based on the information provided, no arrests were made for this incident and both parties involved in the domestic agreed to separate.

On 4/14/23, officers responded to a theft complaint in the area of Wind Forest Drive. Officers made contact with the complainant who reported equipment stolen from a construction site. There are no known suspects at this time and the investigation is ongoing.

On 4/14/23, officers were dispatched to the area of State Route 73 and Bunnell Hill Road for a traffic offense. Officers initiated a traffic stop and while investigating, officers determined the driver was impaired. The driver was charged with operating a vehicle while under the influence, having an open container in the vehicle, and later transported to the Warren County Jail.

On 4/18/23, officers responded to a criminal damaging complaint in the area of Sycamore Trails Drive. Officers made contact with the complainant who reported damage to yard ornaments at the front of their residence. There are no known suspects at this time and the investigation is ongoing.

On 4/23/23, officers were dispatched to a crash in the area of East State Route 73 and Silver Lake Drive. While responding to the crash, officers were advised one of the drivers fled the scene. The driver is unknown at this time and the investigation is ongoing.

On 4/25/23, officers were dispatched to the area of State Route 122 and State Route 48 for an assault complaint. Officers made contact with all subjects involved at the scene and based on the information provided, a suspect was charged with assault.

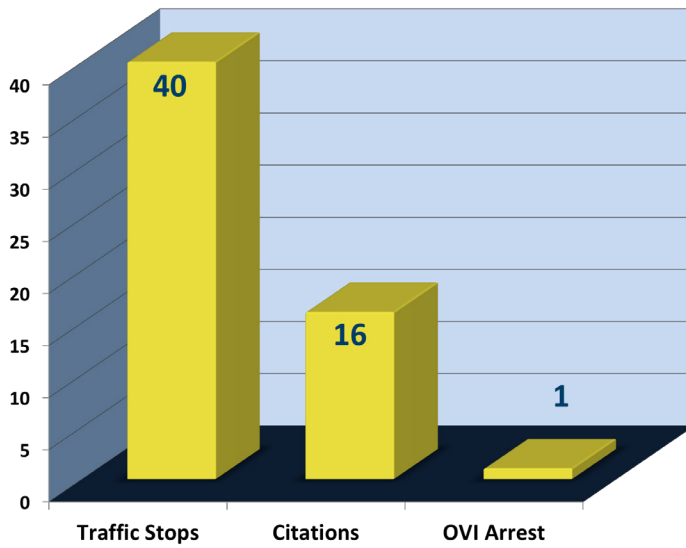


Officers completed the annual handgun qualifications and training.

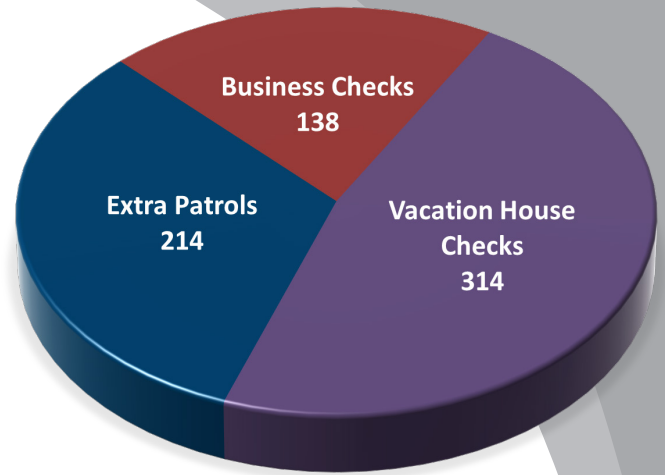

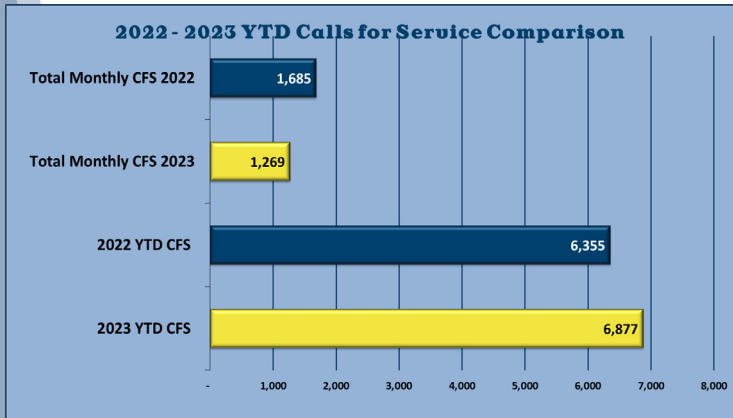

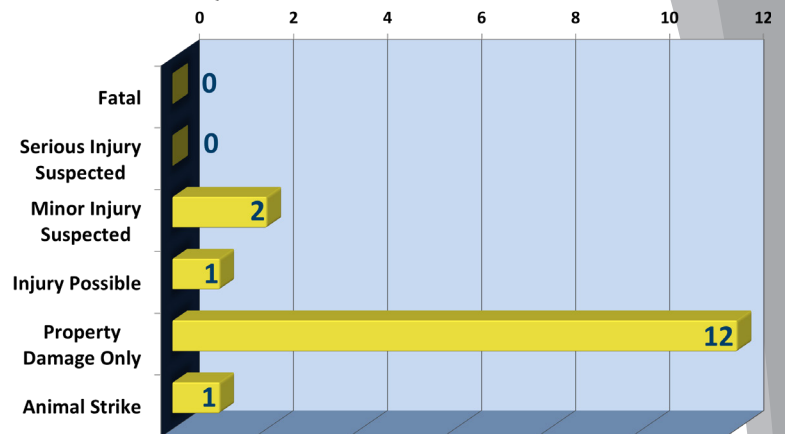

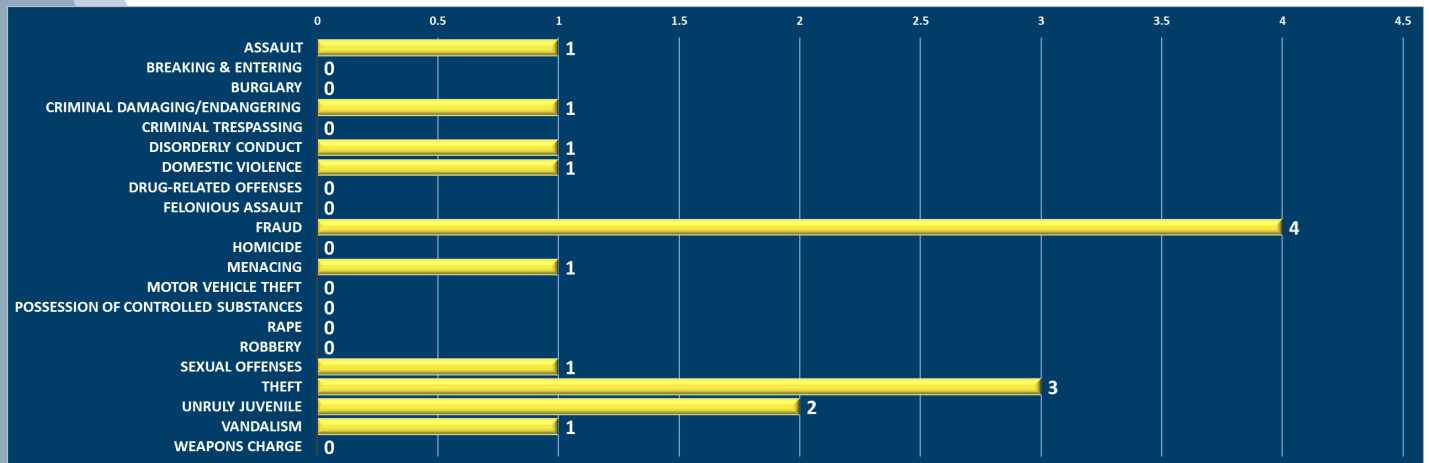
2022 - 2023 YTD Calls for Service Comparison
