Significant Activity

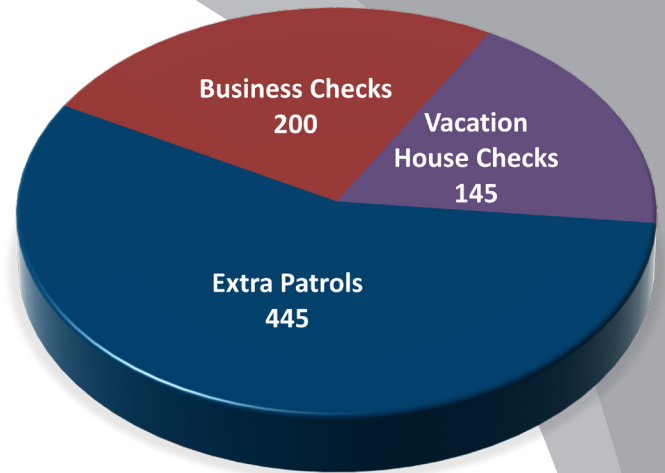

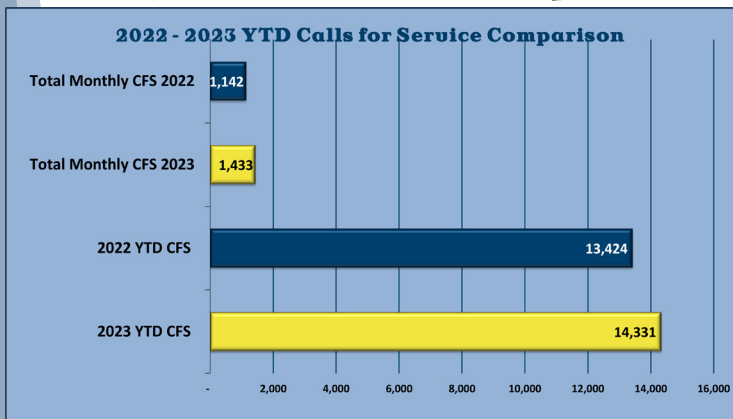

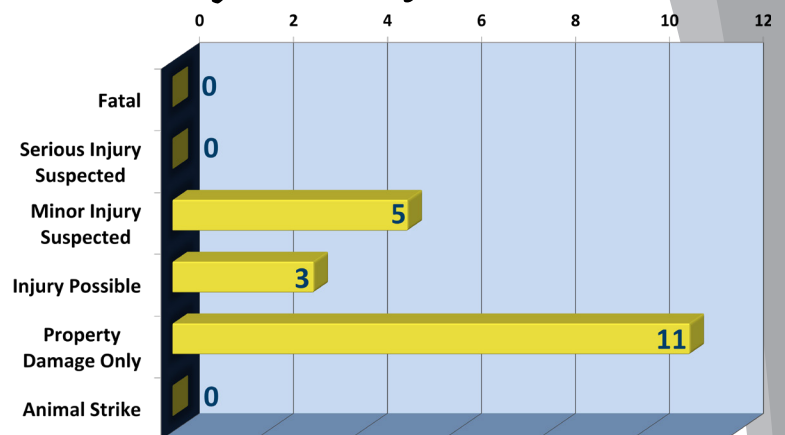

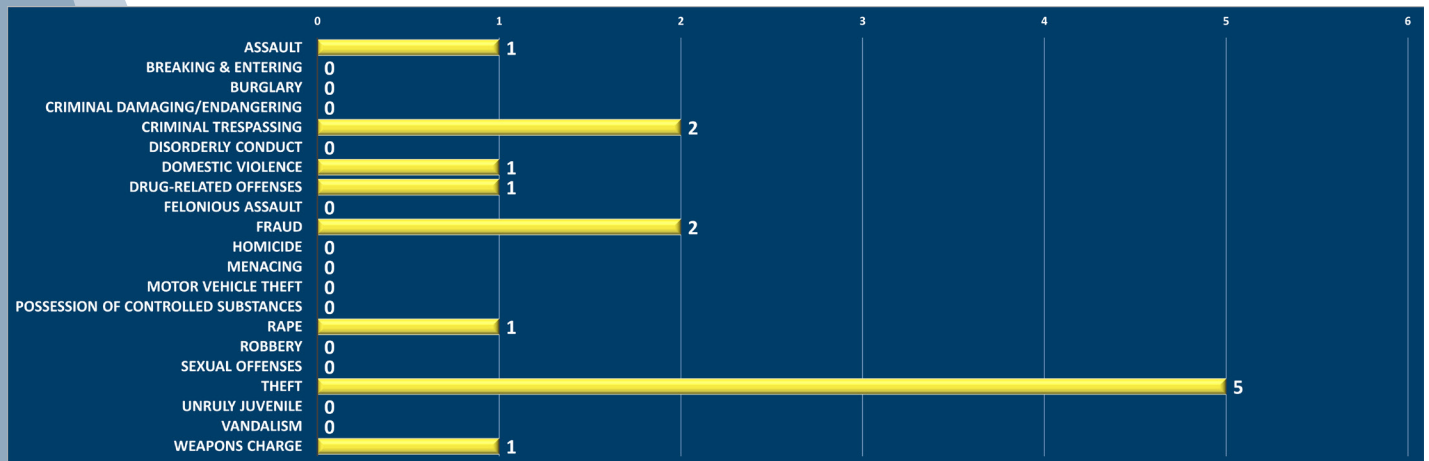
2022 - 2023 YTD Calls for Service Comparison
