## Monthly Report

December 2023

The Road Department received Beet Heat tanks for the dump trucks, in preparation for winter snow events. The delivery allowed time for crews to assemble the tanks and fabricate the Prewet system. Crews created and tested several designs before installing the system. Kudos to Road Crews for their efficiency and teamwork on this project. Your innovation worked extremely well. Keep up the excellent work!



During December, crews dug the trench for a Warren County Technical Rescue Team training on Trench Rescue and also attended the training.

Additionally, crews installed new shelving units and organized equipment.



### 2023 Major Accomplishments:

1. Paved 4.9 miles of roadway. \$698,012
2. Cape Sealed .661 miles of pavement. \$69,527
3. Striped 6.386 miles of roadway. \$21,535
4. Changed nine road culverts ranging from 12" to 60" in diameter and up to 60' long.
5. Changed six driveway pipes
6. Cleaned 25 ditches
7. Repaired the crumbling cul-de-sac in Winding Creek before paving, removing 493 tons of mud, and replacing it with 327 tons of rock and 166 tons of asphalt. \$34,941
8. Rebuilt six Catch Basins
9. Repaired the berm along Factory Road
10. Purchased 938 tons of gravel. \$12,663
11. Purchased 341 tons of asphalt for road repair. \$34,100
