



Clearcreek Road Department

Monthly Report

April 2023

In April, Road Crews moved the block wall from below the salt bin to the top of the parking lot and created seven 18' x 12' gravel bins. Each bin holds 48 tons of gravel and will expedite loading for road repairs.



Road Crews worked with Warren County Highway Department to remove a large tree that fell onto the roadway at Weidner and Lower Springboro Roads during a storm. Clearcreek Road Maintenance cleared the tree; Warren County crews repaired the damaged guardrail.



The Road Maintenance Department purchased a 7' x 14' trailer in April. The new trailer allows room for the Bomag roller and other equipment needed for road repair. Road crews previously made several trips to transport equipment to job sites.

Crews also repaired the potholes at the intersection of Bunnell Hill Road and State Route 73.

Additionally, crews prepared the area of Pine Brook Lane for culvert pipe replacement by adding a bypass lane to allow for traffic flow. Crews will begin the replacement in May.



Crews also replaced a 12" x 50' pipe on Gertrude Avenue.



Finally, crews repaired the asphalt on Bunnell Hill Road at Crown Point. The repair required a 24" x 301' patch using gravel 12" deep under the asphalt. Along with the road repair, crews cleared the catch basin to prevent overflow during heavy rain.
