## Monthly Report October 2024



### Excellence Through Training

Officers took part in the Warren County Combined Training Group annual training which covered Active Shooter Response, High-Risk Traffic Stops, and Patrol Level Breaching and Tools.



### On the Call

#### Significant Activity

On 10/30/24, Corporal Knobbe and Officers Bronnenberg and Hall responded to the 6000 block of Bunnell Hill Road for a juvenile complaint. Upon investigation, officers charged a juvenile with Failure to Comply with Order or Signal of a Police Officer, Unruly Juvenile, and Resisting Arrest.

On 10/26/24, Sergeant Sweet observed a motorist cross the center line into the opposing travel lane while on routine patrol. Further observation showed the motorist driving at a slow speed and impeding traffic. Officers conducted a traffic stop and detected an odor of an alcoholic beverage from the motorist. Upon further investigation, officers charged the driver with OVI, Driving Under OVI Suspension, and Driving in Marked Lanes.

On 10/24/24, Officers Robinson and McWhorter responded to the Warren County Alternative School at the request of Butler County Probation. A juvenile was taken into custody for an outstanding warrant and turned over to the Butler County Sheriff's Office.

On 10/20/24, Officer Horwarth observed a suspicious vehicle while patrolling the area of Hillcrest Drive. Officers conducted a traffic stop and found the operator driving without a valid driver's license and an expired registration. A passenger was also in the vehicle. Officers conducted an inventory search of the vehicle before towing and found an item linked to a recent vehicle theft in the area. Charges were later filed on the driver for Receiving Stolen Property and on the passenger for Complicity to Receiving Stolen Property.

On 10/18/24, Sergeant Sweet and Officers Bronnenberg and Hall responded to the 3000 block of North US 42 for a vehicle in a ditch. Upon arrival, officers noticed a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage on the motorist. Officers performed field sobriety tests and charged the driver with OVI and Operating without being in Reasonable Control.

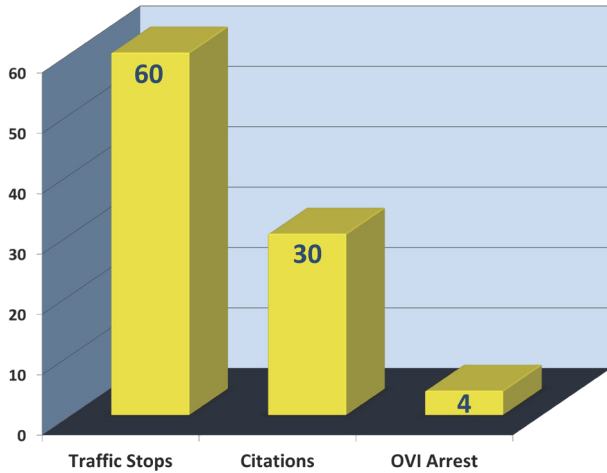
On 10/15/24, Sergeant Sweet and Officers Bronnenberg and Edwards responded to a possible intoxicated driver on North State Route 48 and Hemmingway Drive. Officers located the motorist and noticed the odor of an alcoholic beverage and slurred speech. Upon further investigation, officers charged the motorist with OVI.

On 10/14/24, Officers McWhorter and Robinson were dispatched to the 9000 Block of North State Route 48 for a suspicious person asking residents for a ride to Indiana. Officers contacted the suspect and found the person had an active warrant out of the State of Indiana. The suspect was taken into custody and transported to Warren County Jail for transfer to the State of Indiana.

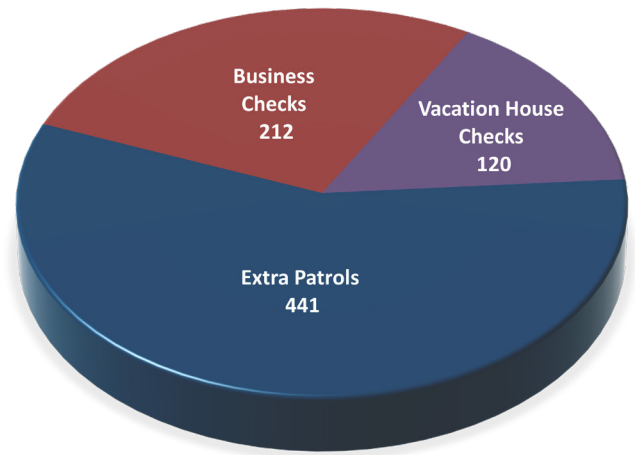
On 10/12/24, Officer D. Williams responded to Belleclaire Hill for a reported suspicious vehicle. Officers spotted the vehicle, and upon seeing the officer's vehicle, the suspect sped away. Officers attempted to conduct a traffic stop, but the vehicle fled towards I-75. The motorist failed to yield to the officer and continued North on I-75 into the City of Dayton. City of Dayton Officers assisted in the pursuit, and the vehicle eventually crashed on a city street. Officers took the vehicle and a juvenile passenger into custody. Officers located the juvenile driver of the vehicle. They charged the driver with Failure to Comply with Order or Signal of a Police Officer, Operation in Willful or Wanton Disregard of Safety, Operating a Motor Vehicle without a Valid License, and Possession of Criminal Tools.

On 10/9/24, Sergeant Bates and Officer Robinson responded to the Warren County Alternative School for a reported physical fight between two students. Upon investigation, officers charged one of the juveniles with Assault.

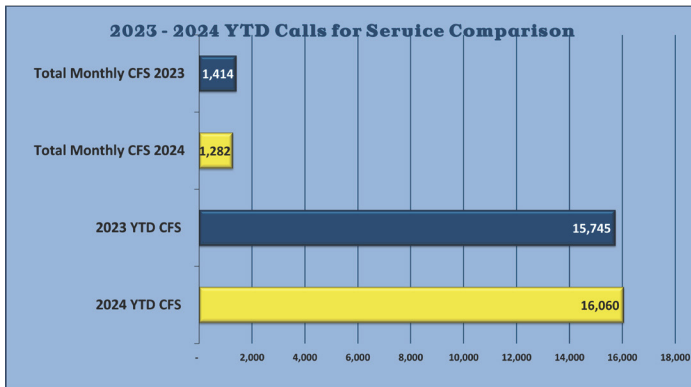

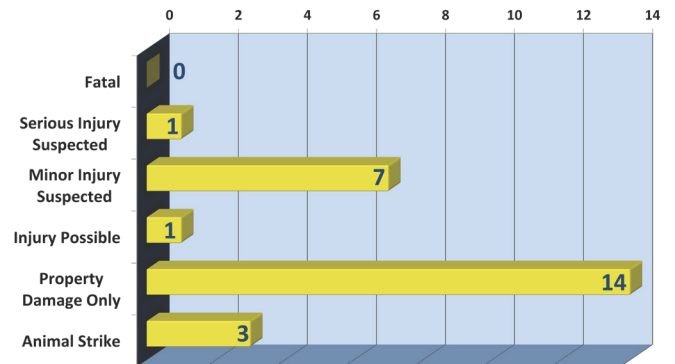

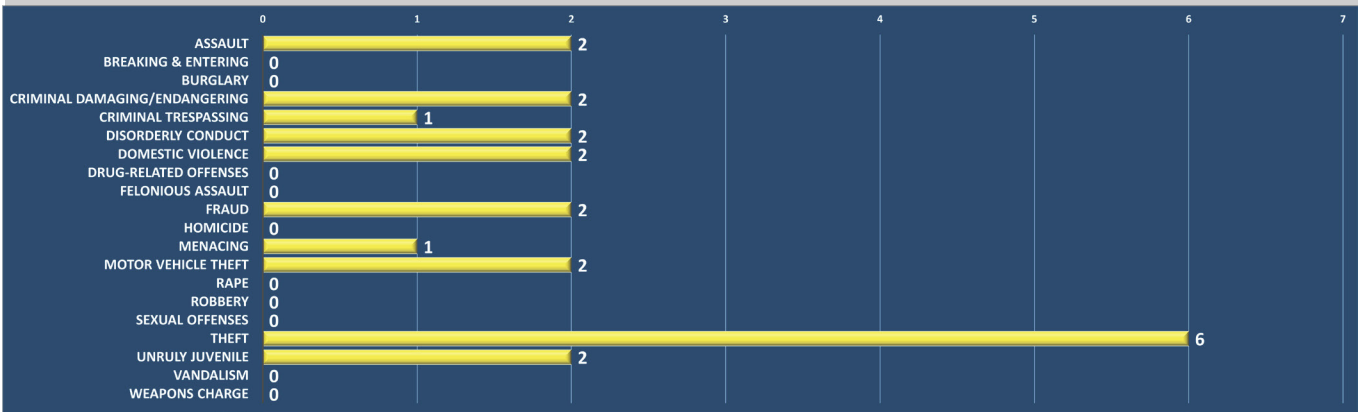
## Calls for Service 2023 - 2024 YTD Comparison
