Significant Activity

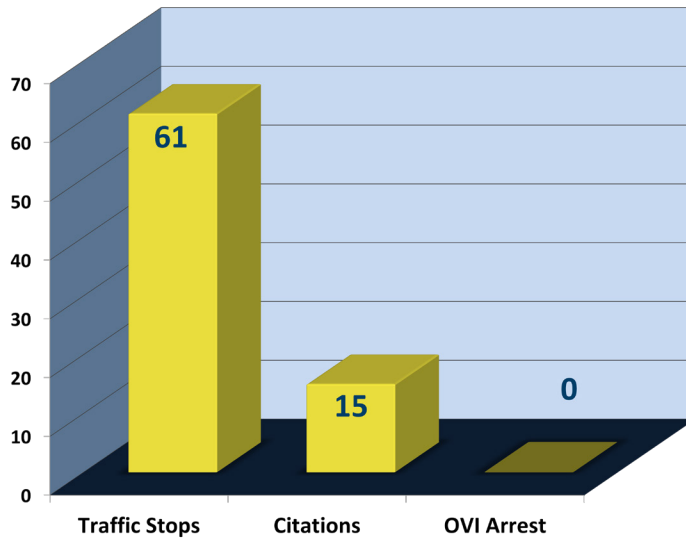
On February 12, 2024, Officer Morgan met with a female complainant at the Clearcreek Township Police Department regarding a violation of a protection order. The female advised that her husband, with whom she is separated from, had repeatedly called her and left voice mails in violation of a current court order. Upon investigation, a warrant was obtained for the male, and he was arrested later that day for Violation of a Protection Order.

On February 16, 2024, Corporal Morgan and Officer McWhorter were dispatched to a residence in the 8700 block of Sycamore Trails for a reported domestic dispute in progress. Prior to officers' arrival it was further reported that a female in the dispute was in possession of an axe. Upon investigation it was found that two females at the residence had gotten into a physical altercation and that one of the females sustained injury to her hand and face. The female aggressor was arrested for Assault and Aggravated Menacing and transported to the Warren County Jail.

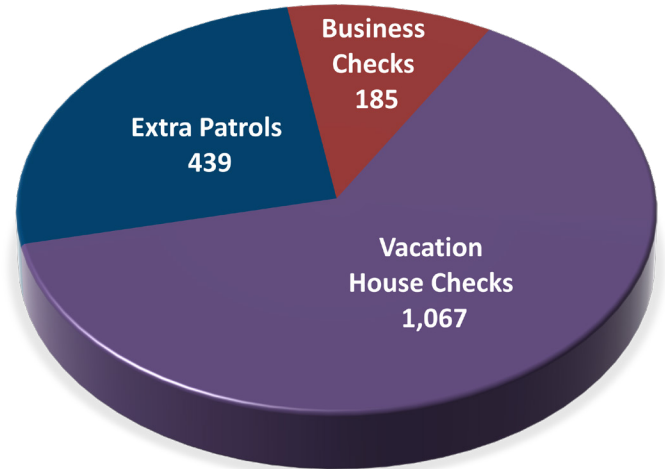
On February 20, 2024, Officer Bronnenberg stopped a motorist for a traffic violation near the intersection of West State Route 73 and Farmridge Drive. Upon investigation it was found that the male operator of the vehicle was in possession of a firearm and had been consuming alcohol. The male was charged with Having Weapons while Intoxicated and transported to the Warren County Jail.

On February 23, 2024, Officer Bronnenberg and Sergeant Sweet responded to a residence in the 9500 block of Crooked Creek Drive for a report of a female running down the street and screaming. During the investigation it was found that the female had been in an argument with her boyfriend in a vehicle and that she had allegedly punched the male in the face. The female was transported to the hospital for health concerns and was then taken to the Warren County Jail on domestic violence charges.

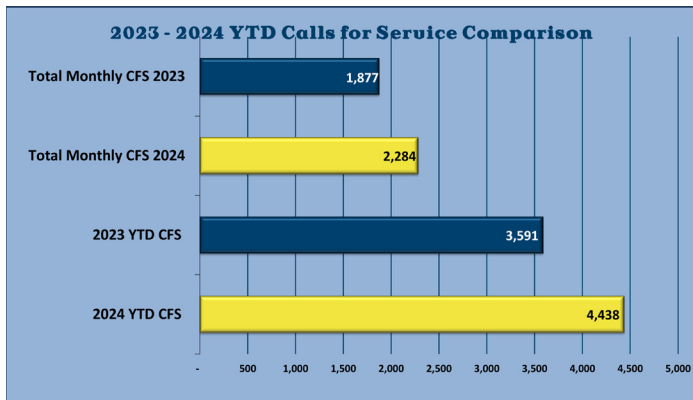

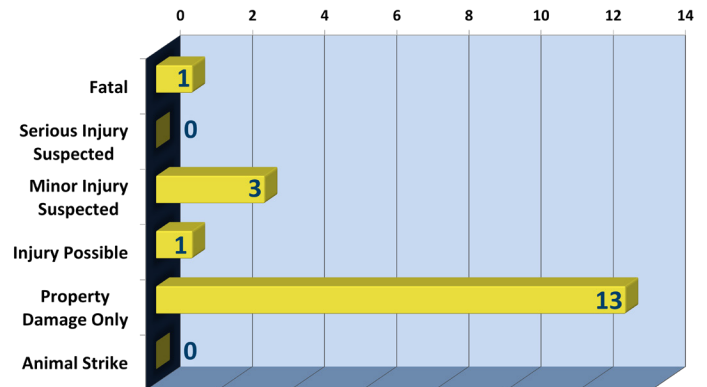

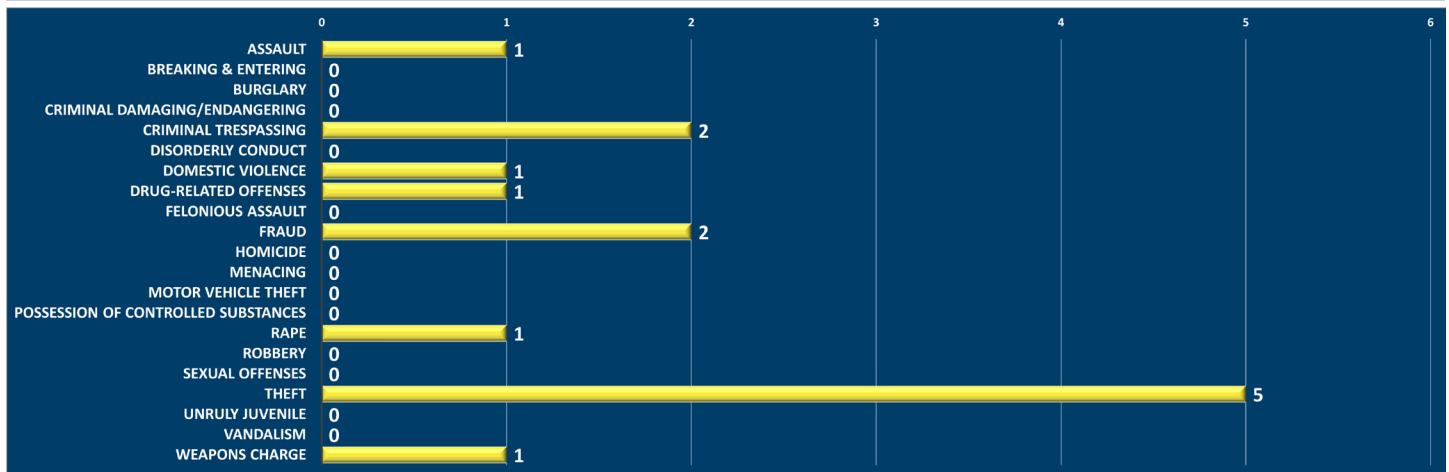
Calls for Service 2023 - 2024 YTD Comparison
