

Clearcreek Road Department

Monthly Report September 2024

The first week of the month, the Maintenance Department contracted a company to pave the salt bin and finished the parking lot for salt delivery.

The Maintenance Department and Parks did a combined project: piping the ditch at the end of the pickleball courts and across the driveway. This consisted of 480 ft of 24-inch culvert pipe and two catch basins.







Tree trimming continued throughout the month, cutting trees back to the white edge line of the roadway. This allows sunlight to penetrate the road, dry the streets, and melt the snow faster. The tree company came in for four Fridays to trim trees on Red Lion Five Points Road from Bunnell Hill Road to State Route 741.

The department changed a culvert pipe on West Pekin Road. This pipe was 36 inches X 55 feet long. While changing this pipe, crews discovered another culvert pipe that had collapsed, which required







an extra day and additional material to cover repairs.

Finally, crews fixed a large pothole in Cypress Ridge on Wisteria Lane, using ten tons of asphalt after milling it
