Significant Activity


On January 9, 2025, Sergeant Sweet, and Officers Hall and Horwarth, responded to a residence in the 2000 block of Whitecap Court for a domestic violence complaint. Upon investigation, a female resident was arrested for Domestic Violence, Resisting Arrest, and Disorderly Conduct.

On January 4, 2025, Officer Bronnenberg performed a traffic stop on Majestic Drive and East State Route 73. When the officer approached the vehicle, the motorist turned his vehicle around and sped off westbound on State Route 73, fleeing the scene. The vehicle fled into Franklin Township with officers from the City of Springboro, Warren County Sheriff's Office, and City of Franklin Police assisting. 








Calls for Service 2024 - 2025 YTD Comparison
