### On the Call

#### Significant Activity

On February 17, 2025, Officer McWhorter was dispatched to a residence on Ryan Road for a report of a vehicle theft. The complainant advised that she had lent her vehicle to her son and he had failed to return the vehicle. Upon investigation, it was found that the son had been arrested by Middletown Police that evening and that the vehicle had been towed. The son was issued a summons for Unauthorized use of a Motor Vehicle.

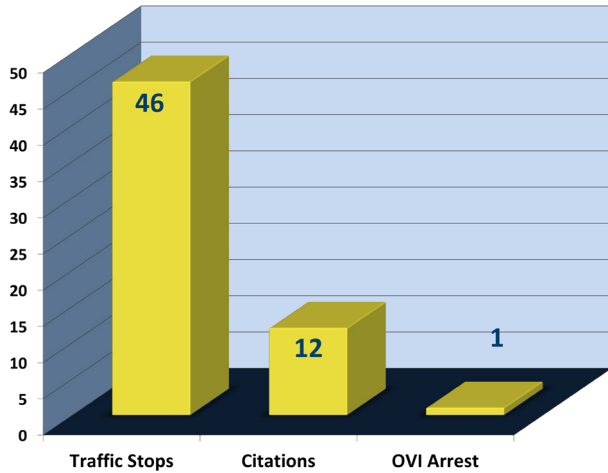
On February 16, 2025, Corporal Morgan responded to the area of CHESS Christian School for a report of criminal damaging. The complainant, who is responsible for the maintenance of the sports fields, stated an unknown person had driven an ATV through the field and had caused damage to the grounds. Upon investigation, officers were able to follow tire prints to a residence on Jarva Lane. A male motorist was issued a summons for Criminal Damaging.

On February 16, 2025, Corporal Morgan and Officers McWhorter and Hall, responded to a 911 hang up call in the 9000 block of Aspen Brook Court. Upon arrival at the residence, officers discovered that the 911 hang up call was the result of a domestic dispute that had occurred at the residence. Upon further investigation, a male was arrested for Domestic Violence.

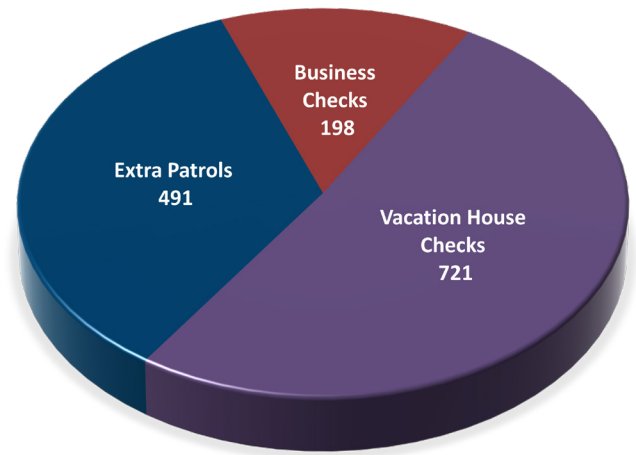
On February 14, 2025, Officer Bronnenberg was on routine patrol when he got behind a vehicle making several marked lanes violations. Officers conducted a traffic stop and found that the male driver had an odor of an alcoholic beverage. The male driver refused to perform field sobriety tests, and upon further investigation, was arrested for Operating a Motor Vehicle while Intoxicated.

On February 5, 2025, Sergeant Sweet and Officer Horwrath responded to a residence in the 9000 Block of Bunnell Hill Road for a domestic dispute. Upon arrival, the female caller stated a male at the residence had grabbed her neck and pushed her down. She further stated the male had damaged the front door to the residence. The male was not at the scene upon officers' arrival. Charges were filed and a warrant obtained. On February 26, 2025, Officer Hall located that male involved in the incident and he was charged with the Assault.

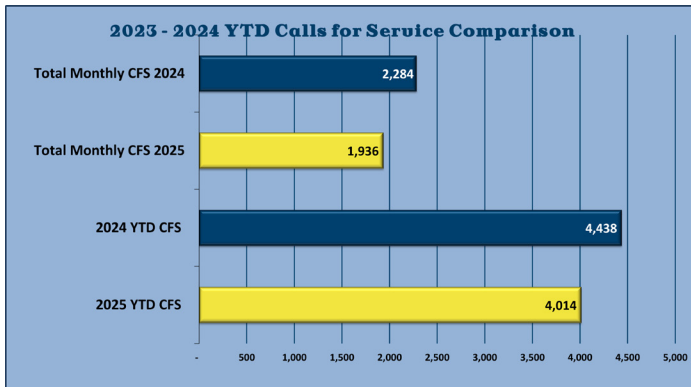

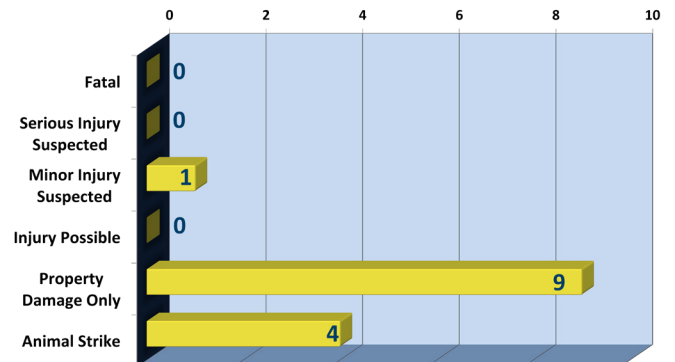

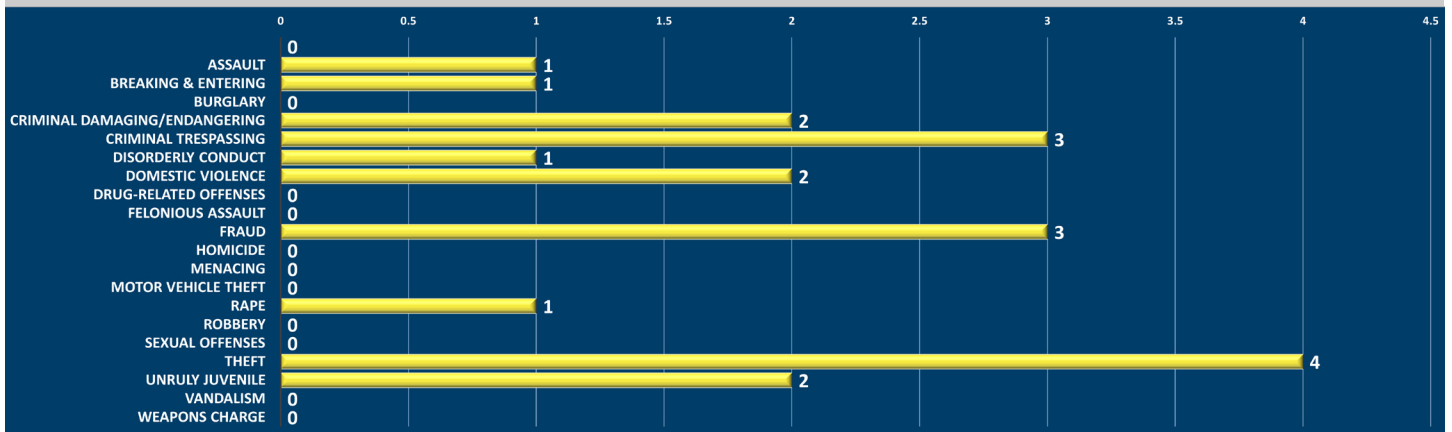
## Calls for Service 2024 - 2025 YTD Comparison
