#### Station 24 Updates

While the inclement weather caused some setbacks, construction crews made good progress on Station 24 in January. During the first week of the month, they completed the underground plumbing installation, including backfilling the trenches. The masonry contractor has the north wall construction up to and within bearing elevation and began work on apparatus bay walls. Electricians ran conduits and boxes for floor boxes within the foundation slab. During the following week, the electric conduit was completed, along with the finishing the north wall. Crews also laid the below-grade walls for the south and east apparatus bays and east side of the training tower.



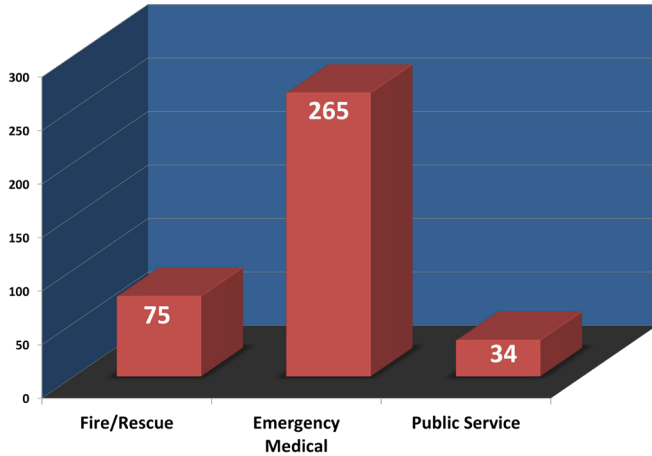

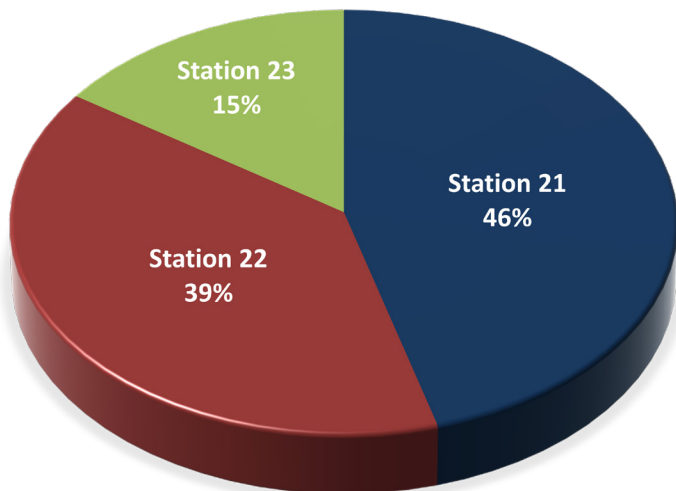
## Alarms by Service Type

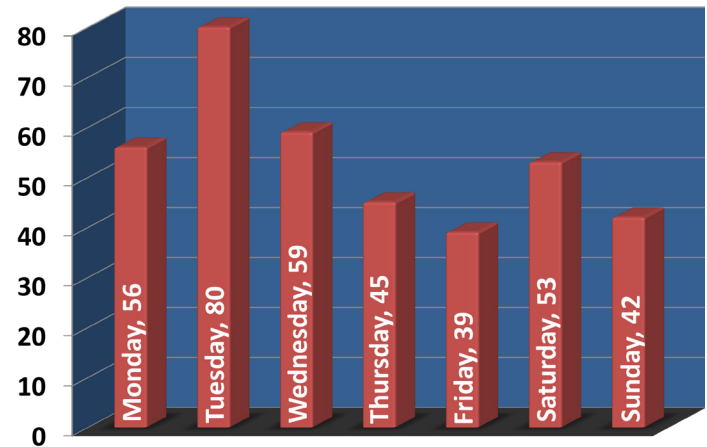
## Response Percentages

## Significant Responses

On 1/2/24 @ 15:14 hours, crews responded to a residence for a reported cardiac arrest. Upon arrival, crews determined the patient was DOA. Crews contacted the coroner and released the scene to Clearcreek PD.

On 1/13/24 @ 00:48 hours, crews responded to a residence for a reported unconscious person. Upon arrival, crews found the patient in cardiac arrest. Crews initiated ALS procedures and transported the patient to Atrium Medical Center.

On 1/13/24 @ 15:34 hours, crews responded to a residence for a reported cardiac arrest. Upon arrival, crews determined the patient was DOA. Crews contacted the coroner and released the scene to Springboro PD.

On 1/14/24 @ 12:39 hours, crews responded to a residence for a reported cardiac arrest. Upon arrival, crews determined the patient was DOA. Crews contacted the coroner and released the scene to Clearcreek PD.

On 1/16/24 @ 04:34 hours, crews responded to State Route 741 and Oakland Hills Court for a reported vehicle accident with injuries. Upon arrival, crews found a single car off-road. Crews transported one patient and Joint Emergency Services (JEMS) transported another patient to Dayton Children's Hospital South. After securing the site and finding no additional hazards, crews released the scene to Ohio State Patrol. JEMS provided mutual aid assistance.



On 1/16/24 @ 08:22 hours, crews responded to Bunnell Hill Road for a reported chimney fire. Upon arrival, crews found a two-story residence with nothing showing. Investigation showed fire contained to a firebox with smoke entering into the interior of the building. Crews noted smoke on the first and second floors of the home. Crews extinguished the fire using a pressurized water can. Crews noted heat damage to the firebox and fireplace area. Crews tagged out the fireplace, pending inspection. The estimated property damage due to fire is \$1,000.

On 1/16/24 @ 09:00 hours, crews responded to a nursing home for a reported cardiac arrest. Upon arrival, crews determined the patient was DOA. Crews contacted the coroner and released the scene to Springboro PD.



On 1/16/24 @ 20:27 hours crews responded mutual aid into Wayne Township for a reported building fire. Upon arrival, crews found a single-story barn fully involved in fire. Crews deployed a defensive strategy and assisted in extinguishing the fire until released by command.





On 1/19/24 @ 09:15 hours, crews responded to North State Route 741 for a reported vehicle accident with injuries. Upon arrival, crews found a semi-truck had rolled over with the contents spilled onto the roadway. All occupants evacuated the vehicle before crew arrival. Crews transported two patients to Atrium Medical Center. Crews secured the site of hazards and requested a tow company and equipment to clear the roadway. Finding no additional hazards, crews released the scene to Ohio State Patrol.



On 1/20/24 @ 11:45 hours, crews responded to a residence for a reported cardiac arrest. Upon arrival, crews found a patient in cardiac arrest with Springboro PD performing CPR. Crews initiated ALS procedures and transported the patient to Atrium Medical Center.

On 1/22/24 @ Crew responded to a residence for a reported cardiac arrest. Upon arrival crews determined the patient was DOA. Crews contacted the coroner and released the scene to Clearcreek PD.

On 1/23/24 @ 09:11 hours, crews responded to a residence for a reported cardiac arrest. Upon arrival, crews found a patient in cardiac arrest with Clearcreek PD performing CPR. Crews initiated ALS procedures and transported the patient to Kettering Health Main Campus.



On 1/30/24 @ 18:53 hours, crews responded to East Lower Springboro Road for a reported building fire. Upon arrival, crews found a barn fully involved in fire. The homeowner reported vehicles inside the barn and investigation showed a propane tank on the side of the building with potential exposure to another structure. Crews extinguished the fire using water from Rescue 21, supply lines from a hydrant, and foam. Washington Township and Wayne Township provided mutual aid assistance. The estimated property loss due to fire is \$250,000.



On 1/31/24 @ 09:34 hours, crews responded to a school for a reported active seizure. Upon arrival, crews found a patient in cardiac arrest with a witness performing CPR. Crews initiated ALS procedures and transported the patient to Atrium Medical Center.
