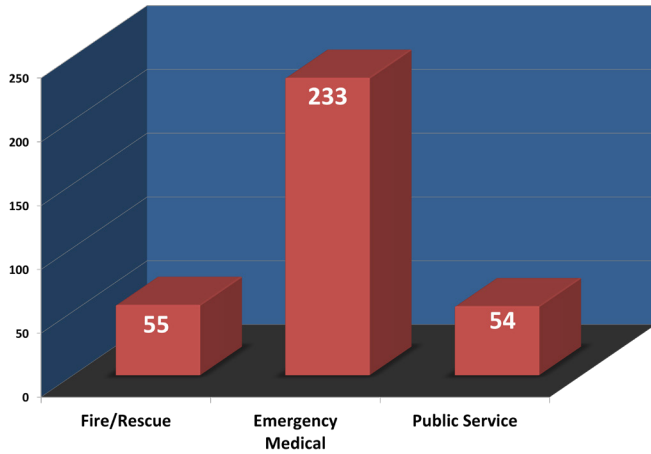

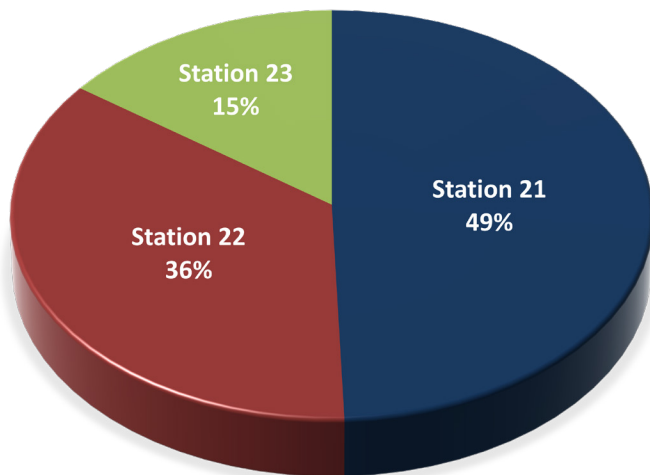
## Alarms by Service Type

2023 = 05:48	2023 = 06:04

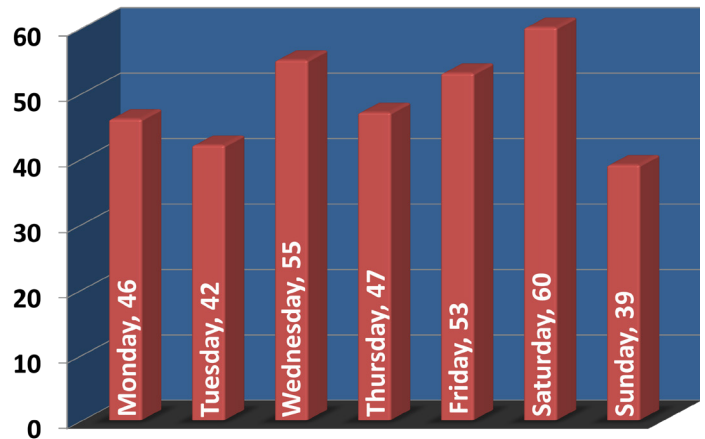
## Response Percentages

## Significant Responses

On 11/2/24 at 07:11 hours, crews responded to West State Route 122 for a reported motor vehicle accident with injuries. Upon arrival, crews found one car off road, on its top, with no occupants. Rescue 21 and Medic 23 shielded the scene while crews performed a search of the area, including the use of thermal imaging cameras, but did not find the driver or any passengers. Crews secured the site of hazards and released the scene to Clearcreek PD.



On 11/13/24 at 12:47 hours, crews responded to Yankee Road for a reported passenger vehicle fire. Upon arrival, crews found a working motorcycle fire. The driver was off the vehicle and reported no injuries. Crews mitigated traffic and protected the scene with Ladder 22 while extinguishing the fire. Finding no additional hazards, crews released the scene to Springboro PD. The estimated property damage due to fire is \$17,500.

On 11/20/24 at 23:56 hours, crews responded to a residence for a reported cardiac arrest. Upon arrival, crews found a patient in cardiac arrest. Crews initiated ALS procedures with no response from the patient. Medical control provided a field termination of resuscitation efforts order. Crews contacted the coroner and released the scene to Springboro PD.
